Early in her journey with heart issues she discovered a passion for advocacy. She believes that knowledge is power and set about to not only help herself but to share her knowledge with others. She believes that with support heart failure patients can impact their own care through knowledge and self advocacy. Also recognizing the inconsistent access to care across the country, she has a specific interest in improving women's heart health care.

In 2017 Jackie started a Facebook support group called "Canadian Women with Medical Heart Issues." which now has 1000+ members. She is a proud member of the Canadian Women's Heart Health Alliance since its inception and she supports Heart & Stroke on various projects locally and nationally. Most actively, she is the Manitoba Champion for HeartLife Foundation of Canada. She has also organized World Heart Day events in her community.
