#### **Biography**

Dr. Tracey JF Colella is a Scientist and clinician at the University Health Network/Toronto Rehabilitation's Cardiovascular Prevention and Rehabilitation Program. She is passionate about patient-centred care and optimizing seamless transitions from acute hospitalization into cardiac rehabilitation and lifelong health behaviours. Her program of research builds upon her experience as a nurse practitioner and focuses on novel interventions designed to improve wait times, patient outcomes and access to cardiac rehabilitation. She has a special interest in sex/gender differences and vulnerable populations - specifically women's health, the frail elderly and high risk surgical populations.

Tracey brings a wealth of clinical knowledge, leadership, research expertise and a strong collaborative approach in her contributions. She has led multiple initiatives within the Cardiac Rehab program involving local, provincial and international partnerships.
