Dr. Green is the Manager of Medical Research and Guidelines at the Society of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists of Canada (SOGC). She received her PhD in Neurosciences and MSc in Pharmacology & Toxicology from Queen's University. Since completing these programs, she has worked on a number of large research projects involving collaborators, stakeholders and partners from across Canada. She was a lead researcher for the Knowledge Translation Core of NeuroDevNet (now Kids Brain Health Network) and worked as the Manager of Research Development at the Canada Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder Research Network.
