Biography

Margot Davis is a cardiologist at Vancouver General Hospital and St. Paul's Hospital, a Clinical Associate Professor at the University of British Columbia, and Director of the UBC Cardiology-Oncology Program and the UBC Cardiac Amyloidosis Clinic.

She completed fellowships in Advanced Heart Failure & Transplant Cardiology and Cardio-Oncology & Cardiac Amyloidosis at Stanford University School of Medicine. She obtained her Master of Science degree in clinical epidemiology at the Harvard School of Public Health.

Dr. Davis is Co-Chair of the Canadian Cardiovascular Society (CCS)/Canadian Heart Failure Society (CHFS) Position Statement on Cardiac Amyloidosis, a Primary Panel member of the CCS Cardio-Oncology Guidelines, and a Secondary Panel member of the CCS Heart Failure Guidelines.

She is on the Executive Committee of the Canadian Heart Failure Society Board of Directors and she is Vice President of the Canadian Cardiac Oncology Network. Her research interests are focused on cardiac amyloidosis, heart disease in cancer patients, and advanced heart failure.
