Biography

When Naomi came down with the flu in June 2020, she had no idea that within a couple of weeks, her life would be completely turned upside down. At 19 years old, she'd just finished her 2nd year of university and was pursuing a career as an elementary school teacher. The virus that she had contracted infected her lungs, causing pneumonia, and her heart, causing myocarditis.

Her heart was severely damaged and she was diagnosed with congestive heart failure. Naomi's condition deteriorated rapidly and after her 2nd hospitalization in 3 months, she was implanted with a Left Ventricular Assist Device (LVAD). The LVAD allowed her to become stable and regain some strength while she waited for a new heart. Naomi only waited 3.5 months before receiving The Call, and then underwent the 9 hour long, life-saving surgery the next day. Since then, Naomi continues to recover, and everyday is thankful that she has been given the gift of life.
