Biography

Dr Louise Pilote is a Professor of Medicine and holds a James McGill Chair at McGill University. She obtained her MD degree from McGill University, MPH from Harvard and completed her PhD in Epidemiology at the University of California at Berkeley. Dr Pilote's research focuses on sex and gender differences in the process of care and outcome related to cardiovascular conditions. Her expertise includes cardiovascular epidemiology, comparative effectiveness, outcomes research, health services research and clinical trials. Through mentorship and capacity enhancement, she is the principal investigator of the GENESIS team: over 50 investigators across Canada conduct research on gender and sex determinants of cardiovascular diseases funded by the Canadian Institute of Health Research and the Heart and Stroke Foundation. She is also the principal investigator of CANAIM, a Drug Safety and Effectiveness Network team to pursue research excellence in comparative effectiveness. She has published over 260 peer reviewed publications and has supervised over 36 graduate students.
