Biography

Dr. Jordan Hutson received her medical degree from the University of Toronto and completed her Internal Medicine training in Toronto. In her 4th year of Internal Medicine she was the Chief Medical Resident at Sunnybrook Hospital in Toronto. Dr. Hutson subsequently completed her fellowship in Cardiology at the University of Ottawa Heart Institute and was the Chief Cardiology Resident in her last year of fellowship. During this time, she developed a strong interest in Cardiac Critical Care and is now completing a fellowship in Critical Care Medicine at the University of Ottawa.

Dr. Hutson's research interests include cardiogenic shock and she was involved in the Multidisciplinary Code Shock Team at the Ottawa Heart Institute, studying our first Canadian Centre experience. She has a strong interest in Medical Education and is very dedicated to medical student and resident teaching. She developed and led the Cardiology program for the Internal Medicine Enrichment & Development (IMED) program for the last two years and designed and facilitated the Acute Resuscitation Workshop for the Ontario Student Emergency Medicine (OSEM) conference in 2019. Dr. Hutson has been the recipient of the Department of Medicine Dr. Donald Cowan Teaching Award in Toronto and the Wilbert J. Keon Award at the University of Ottawa.
