

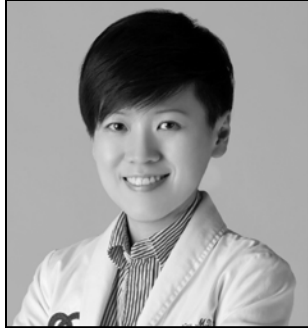

Biography

Dr. Janet Ngu is currently a Clinical Associate in Robotic & Minimally Invasive Cardiac Surgery at the prestigious Cleveland Clinic Foundation and Clinical Assistant Professor of Surgery at the Cleveland Clinic Lerner College of Medicine. Dr. Ngu earned her M.D. and M.Sc. in Cardiovascular Sciences from the University of Calgary. She went on to pursue Cardiac Surgery Residency training at the University of Ottawa Heart Institute. While fulfilling her residency clinical duties, she completed the Global Clinical Scholar Research Training program from Harvard Medical School. After completing her residency in 2019, she received further training through the Advanced Cardiac Surgery Fellowship at the Bluhm Cardiovascular Institute of Northwestern Memorial Hospital, with a special focus in complex valve surgeries, heart failure, and mechanical circulatory support. Dr. Ngu has an aptitude for both translational and clinical research, with over 20 peer-reviewed publications and book chapters to date. In 2018, she also had the honour of winning the Dr. Paul Cartier Cardiac Surgery Resident Award. She looks forward to contributing her surgical and academic expertise to the future of women's cardiovascular landscape in Canada.
